
Why are the requirements wrong?

BEFORE or AFTER Requirements?***




Who does the business process design?

 - Process Design based on Requirements?***


Re-writing the Requirements Narrative

stakeholders.***




Requirements are a byproduct of the business process – not the other way around.

The BA should provide the requirements to the stakeholders.




The Definition of Business

A business is a collection of processes that make money.



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


The BA's role is to be a steward of the process

Business Process Performing Agents




The BA's role is to be a steward of the process

Business Process Performing Agents




A business solution requires a mix of manual processes and automated processes

An IT BA handles process for only IT


Business Process Performing Agents

Requirements Litmus Test

If someone says “The requirements have changed” – What does this mean?




Either you lied about the process....

Requirements Litmus Test

If someone says “The requirements have changed” – What does this mean?



Or the business changed the performing agent from “System” to “Person”

The automation portion of the process changed

Practicing what we've learned....


What would you say if someone tells you they have “Nice to Have” or “Optional” requirements?



Requirements are ABSOLUTE

***Requirements are linked directly to process.
They only change if the process changes***

Business Process Performing Agents



- A business is a collection of processes that make money.
- Stakeholders should only be allowed to present (and agree) on the business process.
- The BA should create the requirements based on the business process.
- There is no such thing as a “changed requirement”. There is only a “changed process”.
- Requirements Management is not a thing (Process management IS a thing).
